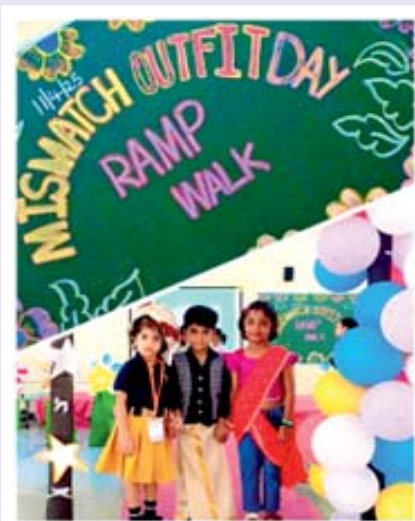


## 11.04.2025: Mismatch Day – Pre Primary Grades

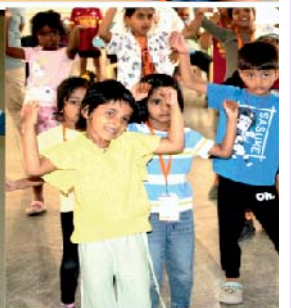

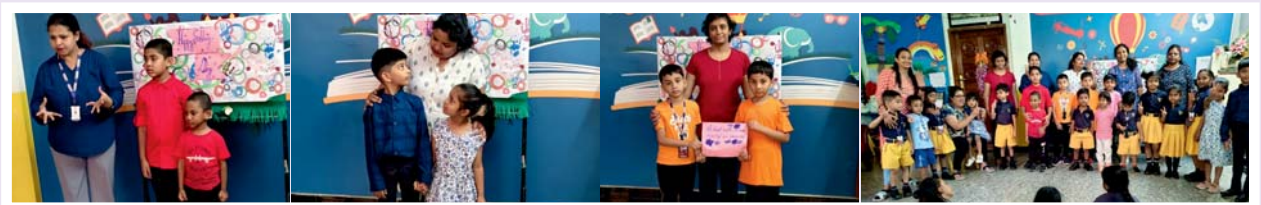
