## 02.12.2025: ASSEMBLY ON 'NATIONAL POLLUTION CONTROL DAY' BY GRADE 4C'

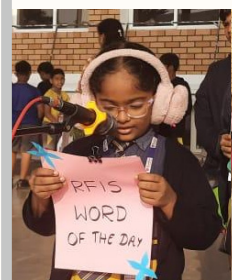
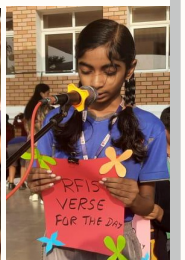
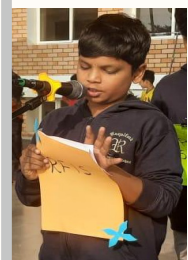
**"Don't pollute, be a solution!"
