

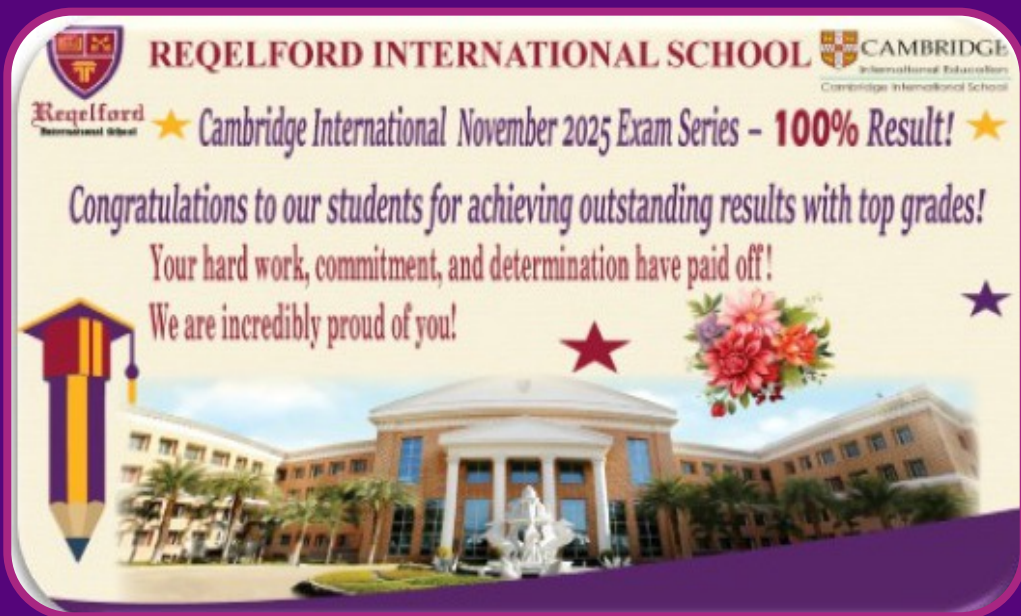

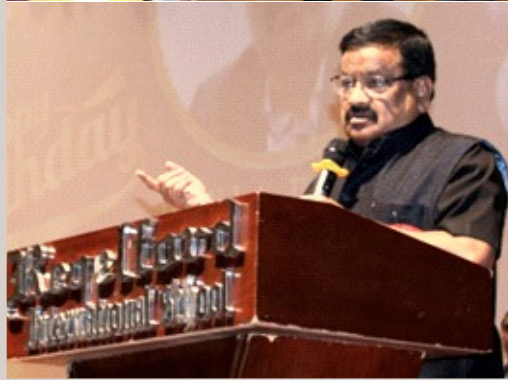


## 05.01.2026: FOUNDER'S DAY CELEBRATIONS

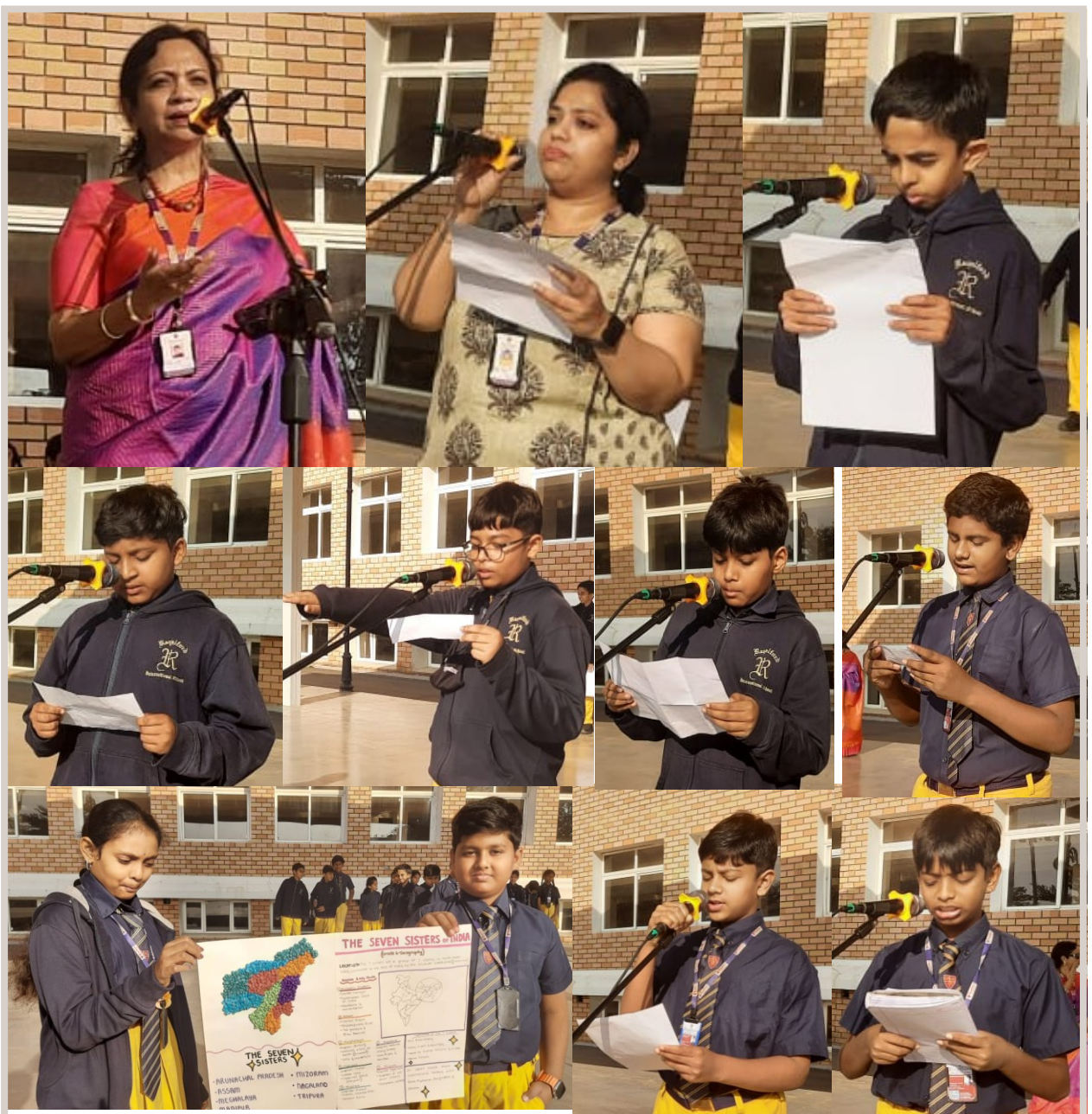


## 19.01.2026: ASSEMBLY ON SEVEN SISTERS BY GRADE 6 CAMBRIDGE

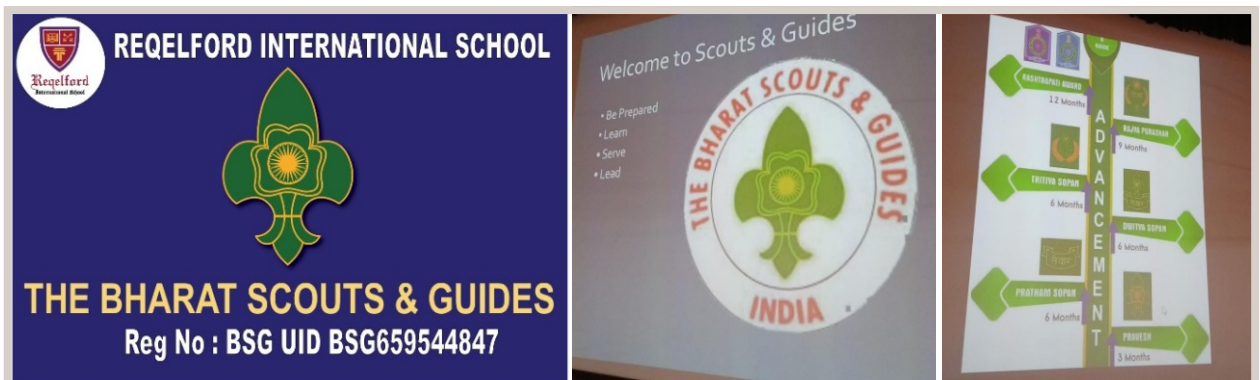
**CLUB ACTIVITY:** Solar system chart on completion by groups showcasing team work and creativity by Grade 4A students

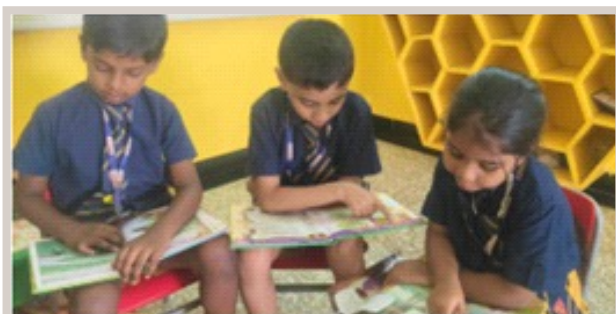
