Focus on the Ganges River Dolphin

Found in the **Ganga, Yamuna, Brahmaputra**, and their tributaries, these nearly blind dolphins rely on echolocation to survive. Their population is declining due to **pollution**, **illegal fishing**, and **river traffic**.

Objectives of Project Dolphin

1. **Species Conservation** – Protect endangered river and marine dolphins.
2. **Habitat Restoration** – Clean and revive ecosystems where dolphins thrive.
3. **Pollution Control** – Tackle industrial waste and plastic pollution.
4. **Curb Illegal Activities** – End harmful fishing methods and poaching.
5. **Awareness Campaigns** – Educate communities, especially those near rivers.
6. **Scientific Research** – Track dolphin health, population, and behavior.

Why It Matters

- Their protection safeguards **entire aquatic ecosystems**.
- They maintain **ecological balance** in rivers and oceans.
- Supports India's commitment to **biodiversity and sustainability**.

Overall, the **Overseas Educational Fair** was a resounding success—empowering students to make well-informed decisions about their future on the world stage.

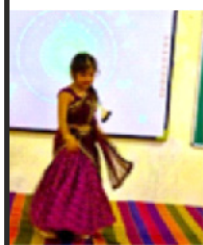
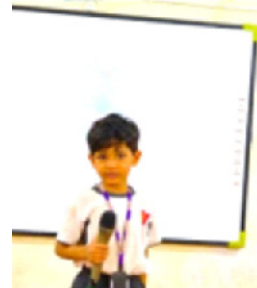
