Our students participated in the DPS, Nacharam Cambridge Competitions and enjoyed the exposure. They received Participation Certificates.

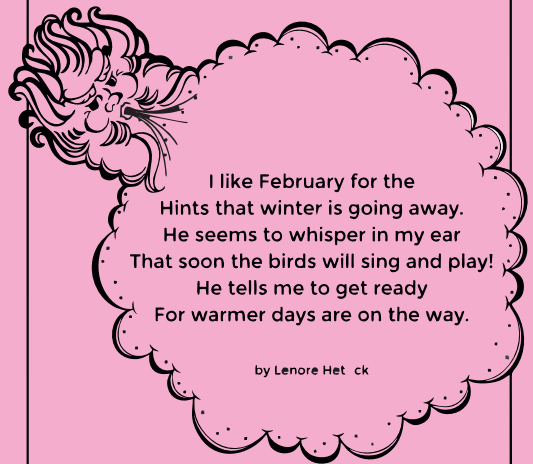
