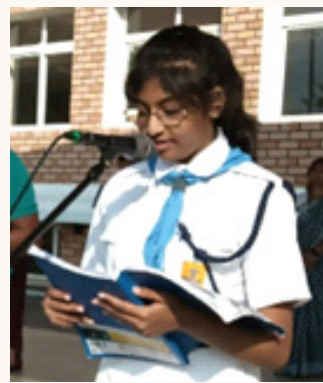
We look forward to many more such enriching experiences that nurture holistic development in our students and continue to shape them into confident, capable individuals.

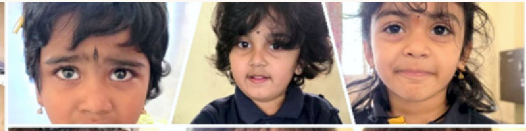




24.03.2025: FRESH NEW SESSION 2025-26

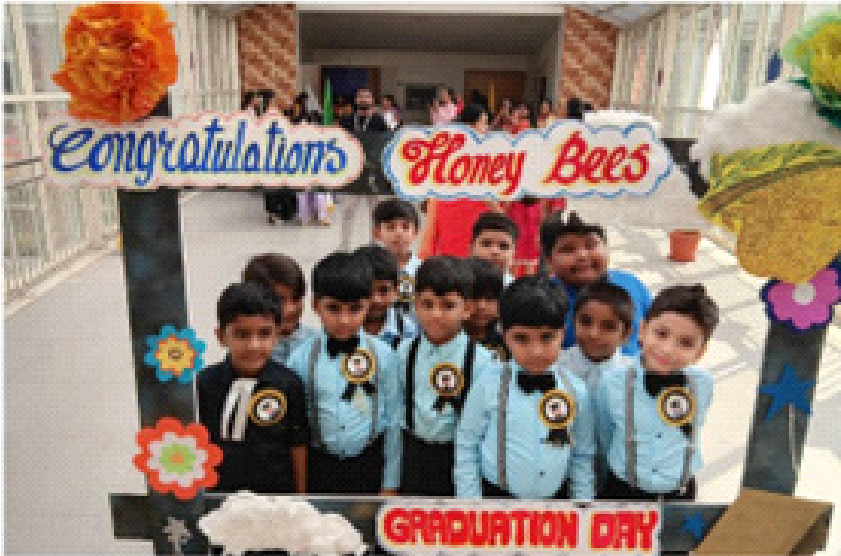
