11.03.2026: EXPLORE THE GLOBE – ACTIVITY BY GRADE 1A

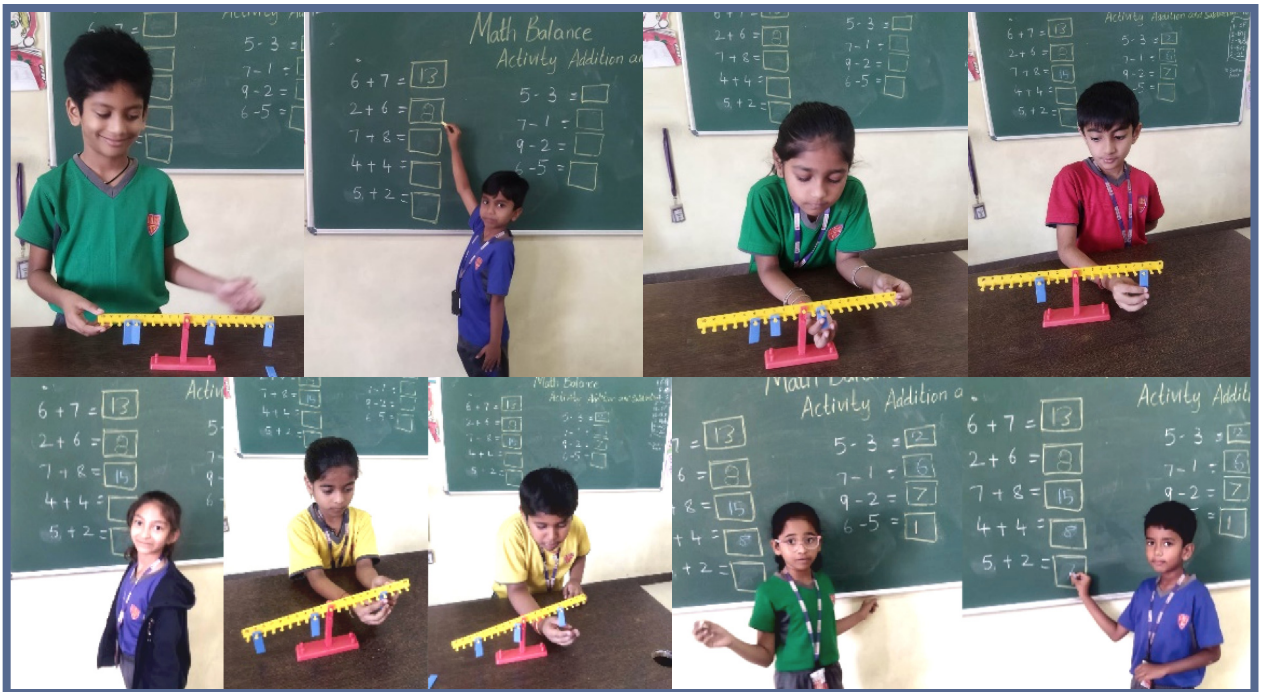
