Each performance and presentation was a testament to the confidence, creativity, and enthusiasm nurtured during the camp.

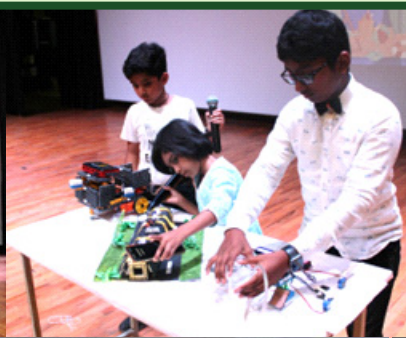
