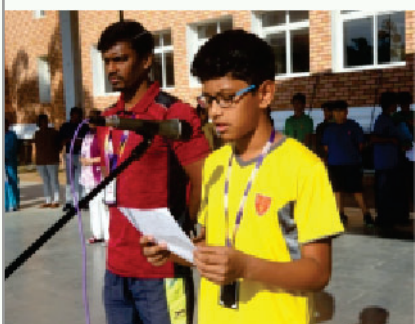
Assembly – VI-IGCSE 11-11-2022
