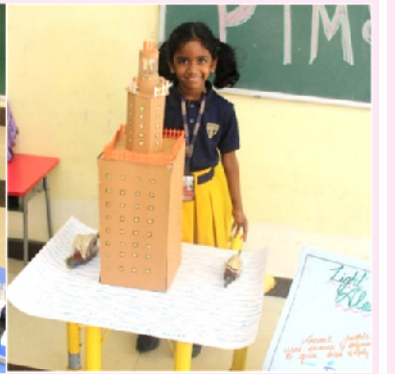
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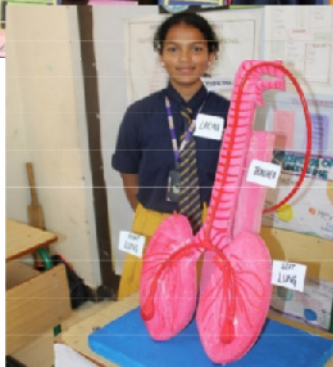

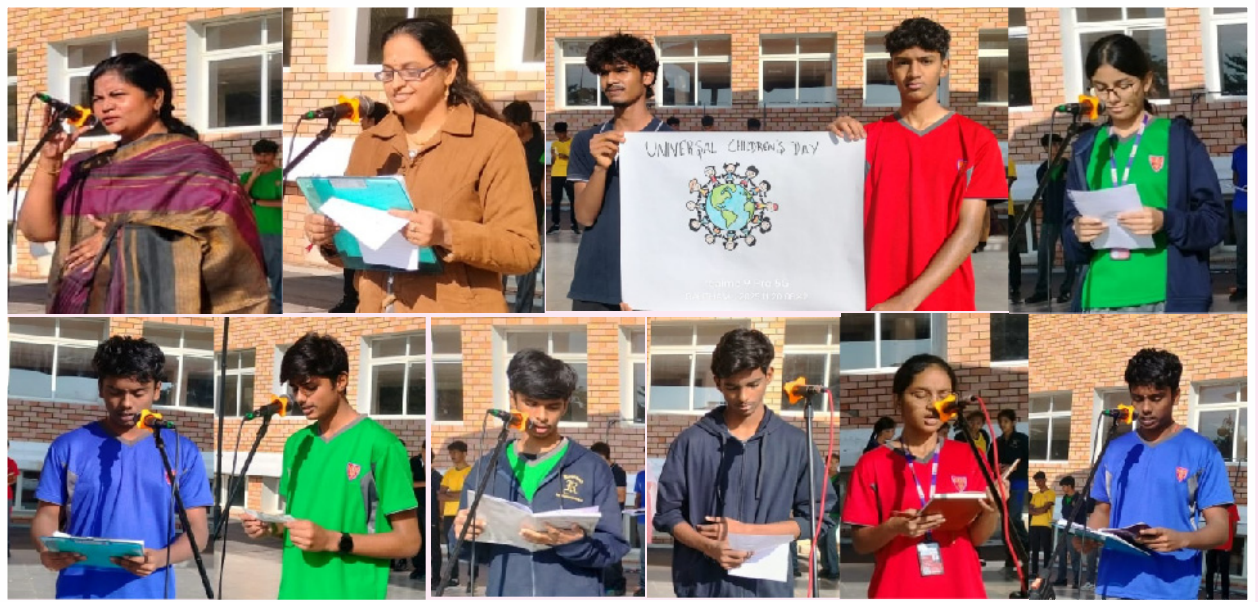
The assembly began with a short introduction explaining the significance of **World Citizens Day** and how individuals of all ages can contribute to a more peaceful and connected world.
